For the 15th consecutive year, the Albany/Capital District chapter of APICS will be awarding a \$1,000.00 scholarship, to be presented at its annual awards dinner the evening of Wednesday, May 8, 2019. Beginning in 2009, scholarship eligibility was expanded to include the general public.

To be eligible for the scholarship program, applicants must meet the following criteria:

- 3. The applicant must be accepted at or currently enrolled in an accredited two or four year college or university
