

The Albany/Capital District chapter of APICS is, for the fourth year, making available up to two \$1,000.00 scholarships, to be presented at its meeting the evening of Wednesday, May 14, 2008.

Participation in this scholarship program is reserved for applicants who:

- 1. Have a sibling, parent or grandparent who is a member of the Albany/Capital District Chapter; or, have a sibling, parent or grandparent who is employed by the same company as a member, and
- 2. are high school seniors graduating in 2008 and accepted at an accredited two or four year college or university; or
- 3. are college students enrolled in an accredited two- or four-year college or university?

Completed applications must be returned with a postmark of no later than April 12, 2008 and include the following:

- A letter of recommendation by a teacher/counselor from the applicant's school.
- An official transcript (and SAT scores if currently in HS)
- An essay of 300-500 words on the topic: "The current and future roles of operations management."
