William C. Martin is The President and Founder of The Initiatives Group, LLC, a management consulting firm specializing in leadership development. He is an extraordinary leader with an impressive executive background. His leadership experience includes overseeing a 24,000 member military organization with a budget in excess of 400 million dollars.

APICS Announces New Lean Enterprise Workshop Series

APICS recently announced the release of a new training course, consisting of seven modules that follow the lean transformation process. In this course, participants will conduct analyses of issues such as increased lead-times and excess inventory; participate in continuous improvement exercises (kaizen); map the value stream, and draft a lean implementation plan for their own organizations.

The workshop modules are:

- Workshop 1: Introduction
 - Educate Organization, Assess Readiness, Define Product Families
- Workshop 2: Lean Culture
 - Plan for Change, Create Teams, Select Pilot Product Family
- Workshop 3: Value Stream Mapping
 - Map Current-State Value Stream, Map Future-State Value Stream, Plan Implementation
- Workshop 4: Stability and Process Improvement
 - Stabilize Demand and Processes, Improve Processes
- Workshop 5: Just-in-Time
 - Calculate Customer Demand, Standardize Work, Create Flow, Implement Pull, Develop Schedules
- Workshop 6: Measuring
 - Define Metrics, Deploy Lean Accounting
- Workshop 7: Sustaining
 - Design for Lean, Continuously Improve Quality, Sustain Lean

The workshop will tentatively consist of 28 total class hours, with 7 of those hours being interactive exercises. A fictional company, Murphy's Toys, is used as a case study model throughout the workshops to give a context for the activities, provide continuity across the series, and enable participants to "experience" a lean transformation. Through this course, participants will complete a self assessment to determine their organization's readiness to implement lean, gain practical experience analyzing how to incorporate lean into organizations, obtain broad knowledge of the subject, and leave with a project plan for implementing lean into their organization.

The workshop will likely be offered within the Albany/Capital District chapter starting in the fall. More details will be provided in future newsletters.
