Driving Directions to Quad/Graphics:

From Albany: I-87 North. Go about 21 miles to exit 13. This is US 9 (also known as Broadway). Go north on US 9. Follow US 9 to Avenue of the Pines. Take a left onto Avenue of the Pines. Go straight through the intersection at Ballston Avenue (also known as Route 50); Avenue of the Pines changes names and becomes Geyser Road. Take Geyser to Grande Industrial Park (Cady Hill Boulevard). Turn right onto Cady Hill Boulevard. Turn left onto Adams Road. Turn right onto Marsel Drive. Please park in the visitors area and enter the building through the doors near the flag poles.
